

At The Clere School we regularly evaluate our careers programme against the Gatsby Benchmarks https://www.careersandenterprise.co.uk/careers-leaders/gatsby-benchmarks/, which is a framework of best practice. Further, we measure the impact of our provision through student voice surveys, work experience evaluations and in monitoring participation rates of students after they leave year 11. Latest published figures show that 96.2% of The Clere school leavers stayed in education or employment after finishing key stage 4, which is above the local authority average (92.9%) and national average (94%).
